

SENSES TANUDA RIDGE PINOT NOIR 2014



THE VINEYARD: LOCATED ADJACENT TO CHARLES HEINTZ AND OUR OWN HILLCREST, TANUDA RIDGE IS A SMALL THREE ACRE VINEYARD PLANTED IN 2001. THE SITE'S COOL MORNINGS, FOGGY DAYS AND LOW ELEVATION TEND TO PRODUCE SOME OF OUR MOST CONCENTRATED WINES.

THE WINE: BING CHERRY NOTES AND REDWOOD SPICE GREET THE NOSE. THE PALATE IS DOMINATED BY BAKING SPICE, RASPBERRY FRUIT AND BRIGHT ACIDITY. STRONG TANNINS ON THE FINISH ARE JUST BEGINNING TO UNWIND AND THE TEXTURE WILL ONLY SMOOTHEN AS IT AGES. THE FINISH IS COMPLEMENTED WITH NOTES OF TOASTED GRAHAM CRACKER.
