THE VINTAGE: 2012 WAS A "VINTAGE" YEAR, WITH MANY GROWERS CLAIMING IT TO BE THE BEST IN LIVING MEMORY. YIELDS 3WERE RECORD-BREAKING HIGH AND THE WEATHER WAS MILD AND STEADY, WHICH ALLOWED FOR EXTRA HANG-TIME AND FRUIT-DEVELOPMENT. WE ARE PROUD OF THE RESULTS OF THIS VINTAGE.

THE WINE: FOCUSED, BRIGHT RED FRUIT ON THE NOSE WITH CHERRY COLA AND HINTS OF GRAPEFRUIT ZEST. ON THE PALATE, BRIGHT RED CHERRY AND WILD BERRY WITH A BLEND OF EARTHY NOTES AND UNDERTONES OF BAKING SPICE. STRUCTURED ACID AND SOFT TANNINS CREATE A ROUNDED MOUTHFEEL.
