Primarily from the famed vineyard formerly known as Keefer Ranch, we bring you the MCM88. An exuberant Russian River bottling from the block originally farmed by Kosta Browne. Our boldest Pinot noir yet comes from a very special block in a very special vineyard now known as Perry Ranch. This addition to the Senses family stands apart from its' siblings with greater concentration and richness. We are very excited about this wine and have named it accordingly.

NAME

MCM stands for Max, Christopher and Myles and doubles for the roman numerals of 1900, which when added to '88 marks their birth year of 1988.

WINE

"Medium ruby-purple in color, the 2023 MCM88 Pinot Noir waltzes out with a stunning perfume of roses, lavender, kirsch, and raspberry coulis, leading to hints of cardamom, cinnamon stick, and underbrush. The medium to full-bodied palate is satiny textured with wonderful freshness supporting the bright red berry and floral layers, finishing long and whispery."
