VINEYARD

Max & Lexi Thieriot planted this vineyard in 2016 after years of searching. This site is located five miles from the Pacific Ocean and experiences the coolest weather of all the Senses' vineyards. Platt Vineyard, de Coelo, and Steve Kistler's Occidental plantings neighbor the site.

WINE

"A deeper red magenta hue, the 2022 Pinot Noir Bodega Thieriot Estate has a fantastic nose with layered depth and a polished feel in its notes of black cherries, black raspberries, fresh leather, violets, and dark spice. The inaugural release of this cuvée, it comes from their newest estate vineyard, planted in 2016 in partnership with Thomas Rivers Brown, located five miles from the Pacific Ocean and the coolest site they work with. Medium to full-bodied, the wine has a lot of energy and power, and it's finessed and long on the palate, with a great finish. It's my favorite of the 2022s in the Senses lineup and has a lot of life to give over the coming 20 years. It was raised in 20-35% new French oak barrels for 10 months."
